OVERVIEW OF SERVICES

- Drafting powers of attorney
- Drafting wills and providing estate planning advice
- Providing advice on contracts and leases
- Providing notarizations
- Advising on family law and domestic relations (divorce, separation, family support, adoption, custody, paternity and name changes); however, legal assistance attorneys are not authorized to prepare or review separation agreements, divorce decrees, or related documents
- Providing advice on landlord-tenant issues
- · Providing resources on immigration and naturalization issues
- Providing advice on special education issues to Exceptional Family Member Program (EFMP) families
- Drafting advance medical directives
- Consumer law to include bankruptcy, consumer fraud, identify theft, illegal lending practices and vehicle leases.
- Providing advice on Servicemembers Civil Relief Act issues
- Providing advice on employment issues including violations of the Uniformed Services Employment and Reemployment Rights Act (USERRA)

Note: Currently serving 111 ATKW members and their dependents have legal assistance scheduling priority due to ANG members in a Title 32 or SAD status being ineligible for legal assistance at active duty installations. Military retirees are eligible for legal assistance at any installation with a servicing legal office, to include active duty installations.

Department of Defense Expanding Access to Military Commissaries, Exchanges and Recreation Facilities

More veterans and caregivers to have eligibility.

The Department of Defense is proud to expand commissary, exchange and morale, welfare and recreation program retail eligibility to:

- Purple Heart recipients
- · Former prisoners of war
- · All veterans with service-connected disabilities
- Individuals approved and designated as the primary family caregivers of eligible veterans enrolled under the Department of Veterans Affairs Program of Comprehensive Assistance for Family Caregivers

The DoD, VA and the Department of Homeland Security are collaborating to implement the Purple Heart and Disabled Veterans Equal Access Act of 2018 for those who will be eligible for this benefit on Jan. 1, 2020. Facilities like these will be open to the newly eligible patrons starting Jan. 1, 2020:

- Commissaries*
- Military service exchanges
- Golf courses
- Bowling centers
- Recreational lodging
- RV campgrounds
- Movie theaters
- And more!

*DoD is required to charge a small fee to new users who are eligible solely under the Purple Heart and Disabled Veterans Equal Access Act of 2018, to cover any increase in costs to the U.S. Treasury for processing commercial credit and debit cards.
