



### CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT LAMAR R.D. BELTON

Chief Master Sergeant Lamar R.D. Belton currently serves as Interim Wing Command Chief, 111th Attack Wing, Pennsylvania Air National Guard, located at Biddle Air National Guard Base, Pa. As the Command Chief, he reports directly to the Wing Commander on enlisted personnel issues to include the following: professional military education, enlisted promotions, mentorship, morale, family, community relations and esprit de corp. He acts as the conduit for information flow between commanders and enlisted personnel, ensuring enlisted members understand the commander's policies, goals, and objectives. Chief Master Sgt. Belton is the advisor to wing boards such as the Chiefs' Council, First Sergeant Council, Top 3 and Rising Six Councils.

Chief Master Sgt. Belton enlisted in the Pennsylvania Air National Guard in July 1989, completing Basic Military Training at Lackland Air Force Base, Texas, the following month. After graduating from Weather Observer training in March 1990, he began delivering critical weather support for the 111th Fighter Wing, including the A-10 aircraft and various Army infantry units, honing his meteorological expertise through numerous stateside and overseas assignments until 2006. That year, he was selected as the Weather



Manager for the 111th Operations Support Squadron, leading his team in providing vital atmospheric analysis and weather forecasting to support global military operations. From September 2008 to April 2014, he also served as First Sergeant for the 111th Fighter Wing, 111th Operations Group, and 270th Engineering Installation Squadron, demonstrating outstanding leadership and dedication to his airmen welfare. In May 2014, he was appointed Section Chief to stand up and lead the newly formed 111th Operations Support Weather Unit, where he managed all formal training and mission weather support for the 103rd Attack Squadron's flying mission, while also advising the Air National Guard's RPA weather community by offering critical guidance and educational support.

Chief Master Sgt. Belton has provided over 15,000 hours in weather support for several overseas contingencies during his military career including Operations ENDURING FREEDOM, SOUTHERN WATCH, FREEDOM SENTINEL, INHERENT RESOLVE AND SPARTAN SHIELD.

Prior to his current position, Chief Master Sgt. Belton served as the 111th Operation Group Superintendent, Biddle Air National Guard Base, Pa
