### CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT SCOTT P. WOODS

Chief Master Sergeant Scott P. Woods serves as Wing Command Chief, 111th Attack Wing, Pennsylvania Air National Guard, located at Biddle Air National Guard Base, Pennsylvania. As the Command Chief, he reports directly to the Wing Commander on enlisted personnel issues to include the following: professional military education, enlisted promotions, mentorship, morale, family, community relations and esprit de corp. He acts as the conduit for information flow between commanders and enlisted personnel, ensuring enlisted members understand the commander's policies, goals, and objectives. Chief Master Sgt. Woods is the advisor to wing boards such as the Chief's Council, First Sergeant Council, and the Enlisted Field Advisory Council.



Chief Master Sgt. Woods enlisted in the United States Air Force in July 1992 and completed Imagery Intelligence Apprentice training at Goodfellow AFB, Texas. After graduation from technical training in March 1993, he was assigned to the 480th Intelligence Group responsible for F-117 stealth fighter automated mission planning products. Following a three-year break in service for college, Chief Master Sgt. Woods enlisted in the Air Force Reserve in January 2000 with the 913th Airlift Wing, Willow Grove ARS, Pennsylvania, as a Combat Arms Instructor, then subsequently cross-trained as an Intelligence Specialist with the 913th Operations Group. In January 2007, Chief Master Sgt. Woods transferred to the 514th Air Mobility Wing, Joint Base McGuire-Dix-Lakehurst, New Jersey, providing intelligence support for strategic airlift, air refueling, and aeromedical evacuation operations worldwide. He was selected as the Squadron Superintendent for the 111th Operations Support Squadron in February 2015 and joined the Pennsylvania Air National Guard.

Chief Master Sgt. Woods has deployed in support of several overseas contingencies during his military career including Operations JOINT FORGE, ENDURING FREEDOM, and IRAQI FREEDOM.

Prior to his current position, Chief Master Sgt. Woods served as Senior Enlisted Leader, 111th Operations Support Squadron, Biddle Air National Guard Base, Pennsylvania.
